OPEN	<p>The open category means there is no differentiation in which category participants choose: heels, art or sports.</p> <p>This category is available for two levels:</p> <p>Beginners - For beginner level polers who wish to showcase their ideas & concept.</p> <p>Judging Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Concept & Creativity - Delivery of concept & tricks - Expressions <hr/> <p>Group - For 2 to 5 pax who are keen to showcase their ideas & concept in a group format.</p> <p>Judging Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Concept & Creativity - Delivery of concept & tricks - Cohesiveness 	Beginner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Only inversion allowed will be inverted crucifix (variations) and layback. - Participants can choose to do 1 or 2 poles, spinny or static. - Criteria will be based on delivery, expressions & concept.
		Group	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For 2 to 5 pax - No limit of levels - Participants can choose to do 1 or 2 poles, spinny or static.
Art	<p>This category is for participants looking to showcase their artistic vision through their item. Concept & delivery takes centre stage in this category.</p> <p>No heels are allowed unless it fits into the concept. Props are subjected to approval and must be inline with concept.</p> <p>Judging Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Concept & Creativity - Delivery of concept & tricks - Expressions - Difficulties of tricks 	Intermediate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In this level, participants must be able to showcase intermediate level tricks such as leg hangs and inversions tricks. - Participants can choose to do 1 or 2 poles, spinny or static.
		Advance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In this level, participants must be able to showcase advance level tricks such as aerial inversions. - Participants must showcase with 2 poles: spinny & static.

Exotic	<p>This category is for exotic lovers looking to showcase the art of exotic pole. In this category, the beauty of marrying floor & heels work, body movement & pole comes together to create expressions in different exotic styles:</p> <p>Flow Old School Hardstyle</p> <p>Heels are a must in this category.</p> <p>Judging Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Concept & Creativity - Delivery of concept & tricks - Expressions - Fluidity & transitions 	Intermediate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In this level, participants must be able to perform fundamental exotic elements such as basic body rolls & waves, pirouettes, heels management alongside floor & pole work. - Participants can choose to do 1 or 2 poles, spinny or static.
		Advance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In this level, participants must be able to perform variations of fundamental exotic elements such as body rolls & waves, pirouettes, heels management alongside floor & pole work. - . - Exotic tricks are not necessary but recommended. - Participants can choose to do 1 or 2 poles, spinny or static.
Fitness	<p>This is the category for all our tricksters! Showcase your love for tricks, interesting combinations & transitions in this category.</p> <p>In this category, clean delivery of tricks, interesting combinations & transitions are the main keys. So if doing tricks is what you love, and wishes to showcase, join us for this one!</p> <p>Judging Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Level of tricks - Delivery of tricks - Fluidity & transitions 	Intermediate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In this level, participants must be able to showcase intermediate level tricks such as leg hangs and inversions tricks as well as linking them together into a combo. - Participants can choose to do 1 or 2 poles, spinny or static.
		Advance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In this level, participants must be able to showcase advance level tricks such as aerial inversions as well as fluid combinations of tricks. - Participants must showcase with 2 poles: spinny & static.

- Finalists will be selected by **15th July 2025** - all participants will be notified via email pertaining to their results.
- Please choose your category & level accordingly, judges retain the right to deduct points should your item not fit the category or level accordingly. *I.e: you may be deducted for performing an advance tricks if you registered for a lower level.*
- Submit ONE registration PER category - if you are planning to enter different categories, please submit a separate one for each.
- Only Term 2 & 3 Euphoria students are eligible for participation.
- Euphoria reserves the right to refuse any participant's registration.
